UniFiji Holds Students Orientation

Explaining the discipline aspect, he commented that to keep a harmonious learning environment discipline amongst staff and students is a key priority at UniFiji. Discipline was also the key factor for success. Hence he advised all to exercise discipline in all areas of engagement as staff and students of UniFiji.

Moreover, Professor Reddy encouraged students to attend all lectures and tutorials. He also advised staff not to cancel classes without proper authorization and in cases of cancelled classes, to reschedule the classes at the earliest possible time.

He also explained the regulations governing the University and advised staff and students to follow all regulations as regulations were meant to safeguard everyone's interest.

Professor Reddy concluded by advising all to refrain from bullying.

"Bulling at UniFiji has risen its ugly head. As adults both staff and students need to be wary of unpleasant outcomes of bulling. Bulling comes in many forms and one of those is usage of unpleasant and unprofessional language. Hence staff and students are strongly advised to refrain from all forms of bulling," he stressed.
