**University Wide Programme
(UUU)**

Overview

The University Wide Programme (UUU) courses have been designed to establish and maintain links with all the University's schools and campuses for the purposes of encouraging, promoting and coordinating interdisciplinary studies on a campus-wide basis. It is the intent of the University to encourage the development and offering of interdisciplinary courses such as Social Research, Contemporary Fiji and Governance and Ethics.

All UUU courses are defined as compulsory courses for purposes of degree requirements for the BA, BCom and BSc degrees. Credits earned through these courses are generally applied to the degree as compulsory credits.

The compulsory courses are:

UUU100 Social Research
UUU200 Contemporary Fiji
UUU300 Governance and Ethics

The University Wide Programme also offers a Postgraduate Diploma in Governance and Public Policy and Master of Arts in Governance and Public Policy.

Programme Structure

The Postgraduate Diploma in Governance and Public Policy programme comprises four 400-level courses.

Master of Arts in Governance and Public Policy

Master of Arts in Governance and Public Policy comprises:

Postgraduate Diploma in Governance and Public Policy plus two other postgraduate courses plus a half thesis.

UUU 406	Special Topics in Development Management and Growth
UUU 600	Minor Thesis

Admission Requirements

Postgraduate Diploma in Governance and Public Policy

- Bachelors Degree from the University of Fiji with a GPA of at least 3.0 in the 200 and 300 level courses in the appropriate major, **OR**
- A qualification obtained from some other tertiary institution deemed by the Senate to be equivalent to the requirements set out in (a) above, **OR**
- A professional qualification deemed by the Senate to be equivalent to the requirements set out in (a) above.

Master of Arts in Governance and Public Policy

- A Postgraduate Diploma in an appropriate field of study from The University of Fiji or some other tertiary institution with a GPA of at least 3.0 in the Postgraduate Diploma courses, **OR**
- A qualification obtained from some other tertiary institution deemed by the Senate to be equivalent to the requirements set out in (a) above.
