## Programme Name: Graduate Diploma in Teaching

The Graduate Diploma in teaching programme consists of <u>eight</u> compulsory courses amounting to 120 credit points. Within the 8 compulsory courses two are practicum units that have a total of 16 practicum weeks.

## **Admission Requirements:**

A Bachelor's degree with double teaching majors or a Vocational Diploma (Qualification that does not have a degree pathway) qualifies students to apply for the Graduate Diploma in Teaching (GDT). The candidates need to have a GPA of at least 3.0 or above in their undergraduate studies. Students wishing to enroll in the program must have 2 teaching high schools subjects from the same department; Literature Language and Communication/Hindi(VosaVakaviti), Accounting/Economics, Maths/Physics, Biology/Chemistry, Information Technology, Office Technology, History/ Geopgraphy or Argiculture, Physical Eduaction (PE), Home Ecomonics and Technical Drawing.

## Duration of the programme:

Students who wish to enroll for full time studies will take one year to complete while part time students will take 2 years.
